I work with individuals, couples and families. When working with young clients I may use Play therapy. Filial Therapy may be used to help teach parents new ways of working with their young children. Sandtray Therapy working with miniatures to create scenes of an issue or problem can be done with both individuals of any age and or family groups. All parties will need to have a commitment of time, energy and to actively participate in the counseling process.

Limits of Confidentiality

As a student intern under supervision our sessions may be discussed as part of my on going Learning and Internship supervision at George Fox University and Life Skills Learning Institute. Any information discussed is for learning purposes and case treatment planning, and will be held in confidence by my supervisors and myself. With your written permission our tape sessions will be used as part of my learning experience and will be viewed by my supervisors and Internship classmates.

As a client of an Oregon Student Intern you have the following rights:
